

6. Go On button has been removed during student suspensions to prevent additional lessons from being completed before logout.
7. The rate increments used to raise students' Part B rates have been slightly reduced to provide a more gradual transition to reading exercises at faster rates. Teachers are still encouraged to use the rate stabilization feature when students reach rate plateaus in addition to assigning practice lessons that will assist students in overcoming rate/comprehension difficulties.
8. Comprehension question selections have been made more responsive to user actions to reduce the chance of mis-clicks and unnecessary delays.
9. Students will be required to score 70% or higher, with less than 2 rereads, on three consecutive lessons with Part A rates higher than Part B rates in order for the average of these three higher Part A rates to determine their new Part B rate.
10. Stories are no longer pre-loaded from within the table and contents panel to improve application performance.
11. Students are now allowed to complete the same lesson multiple times in practice mode.
12. Pressing the spacebar during Part A or Part B slot presentation no longer causes presentation errors.
13. Part A automatic removal rate has been adjusted for greater accuracy in limiting rates to no more than 35% below Part B rate.
14. Student time on task is correctly recorded if student exits Guided Reading™ between Part B and the comprehension questions section.

CLOZE PLUS™

1. Lesson D19 bug that created student "freeze" has been corrected (Mac only).

READING AROUND WORDS™

1. Long paragraph presentations have been corrected to prevent text from being cut off.
2. Book marking bug that did not register users last section completion has been corrected.
3. Excessive spacebar pressing no longer freezes the browser.

D-CODE™

1. *Find Words* font size adjustment made to accommodate longer words
2. Spacebar no longer linked to any Quit functions.

COMPREHENSION POWER™

1. When the "Allow Student to Change Rate (+/-25%)" check box is deselected, students are prevented from changing their existing rates. Selecting this checkbox will allow students to adjust their rates up to 25% above or below their existing rate
2. Several story selections have been updated or replaced to ensure level appropriateness and high interest reading experiences.

MANAGEMENT/REPORTS

1. Teachers now have access to new reporting filters from within the Reports panel. These allow teachers to select grade ranges, gender and sub populations for report

generation, as well as determine the time period from which the reports will draw data (e.g. Last 30 days, 60 days, etc.).

2. Site and class Rate & Level Charts have been adjusted to display content levels in the following divisions: "Below 5+ Levels, Below 2-4 Levels, Below 1 Level, At or Above Level". Note that the color references have been adjusted so that students reading one level below will be represented in yellow wedges and students reading at or above level will be represented within green wedges.
3. The number of completed Guided Reading™ sessions is now included in the Class Summary Report. This allows teachers to distinguish between the number of lessons completed and the number of sessions taken to complete these lessons.
4. This report now includes the total session count as well as the number sessions completed per week.
5. Data from multiple classes is now downloaded into a single CSV (comma separated values) file when users select "Download CSV" from a report presentation containing multiple class reports.
6. New heading in Rate Graph clarifies that only students who are on a rate track are displayed in this report.
7. Time out pop-up message improvement allows users to single click OK to exit out of pop-up and return to the Log In screen.
8. Changing Hi level content starting level for site no longer creates Guided Reading™ book marking inaccuracies.
9. If no matched records can be found for a Site Report "No records found for this site" is presented.
10. The "Allow for Practice" class setting will now be inherited by individual pre-existing students.
11. Suspension icon is retained in Class panel if teacher selects "No" when asked if a student should be unsuspended.
12. Student Summary report labeling corrections have been made (wpm added to initial Part A rate and "lpm" changed to "wpm" for final Part A rate.)
13. If a lesson is pre-read (in practice mode) without completing any questions, the comprehension column will now correctly show a dash (-) instead of 0%.

VISAGRAPH

1. Driver check performed to ensure users are working with version 2.0.1+.
2. The "Student Inventory" and "Examiner Inventory" portions of Visagraph reports no longer display a date next to these headers (since the inventory date is already displayed within the report itself).
3. The simulation will more closely reflect the actual line count. Corrected inconsistency due to eliminating initial and last line.
4. The Total RP Time reported by the Visagraph applet has been corrected and is now accurate.
